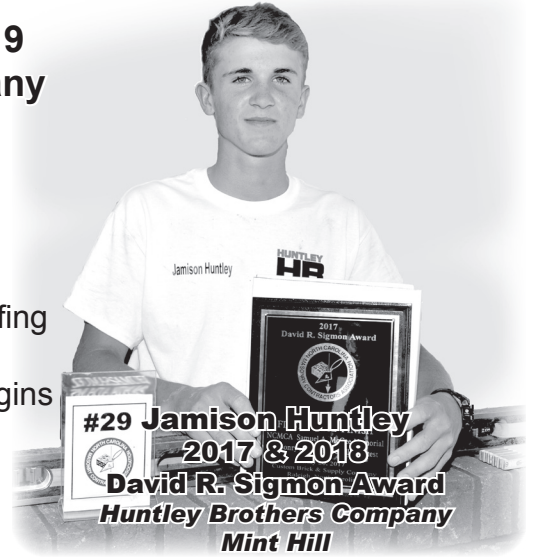

Contest Rules and Regulations

(Contractor member sponsored contestants not employed by the member contractor may compete but are not eligible for the championship.)
- 2) Must furnish tools including trowel, level, square, hammer, modular rule, concave jointers, etc.
- 3) Must wear proper footwear, safety goggles or safety glasses, and an approved hard hat.
- 4) *Must not have completed more than 6,000 hours or three years of training before the competition. Limit of three NCMCA Apprentice Masonry Skills competitions, regardless of hours.
- 5) **Entry fee is \$50 for each contestant.** Fee must accompany this complete application.
